A. Application Forms

- 1. All documents should be submitted on or before 4:30 PM of
2. Application documents shall be submitted to the Admission, Aid & Alumni Affairs Office. These documents are the following:

- For Grade 7 Applicants. Photocopy of Grade Six Report Card (Form 138-B).
For Grade 8-10 Transferees. Photocopy of the Student Applicant's Scholastic Record / Previous Year's Report Card
Recommendation Form in a sealed envelope
Two (2) recent and identical 2"x 2" I.D. pictures on plain background (To be pasted on the Application Form & Exam Permit)
Examination Permit issued by the OCAAAA staff.

B. Enrollment:

- 1. The Enrollment for SY 2017-2018 will start on APRIL 17, 2017. (Mon to Fri: 8:00-4:00 PM; Sat: 8:00-12:00NN)
2. Enrollment documents shall be submitted to the Registrar's Office. These documents are the following:

- Notice of Acceptance / Conditional Acceptance (issued by the Admissions, Aid & Alumni Affairs Office)
Phil. Statistics Authority Birth Certificate (Original) or Certified True Copy of Birth Certificate (For Foreign Students)
Final Report Card / Scholastic Record of Student (Original)
Special Study Permit (For Foreign Students only).

C. Scholarships:

- 1. The results of the Entrance Examination will be a major factor for acceptance into the Magis (Academic), Grant-in-Aid (GIA) & Education Service Contracting (ESC) Scholarship Programs.
2. The Magis Scholarship is granted to the Top 40 students who took the Entrance Examination for the school year applied for.
3. ESC Grants can be applied for by students who successfully passed the Ateneo Qualifying Test.
